Please read and review the following statements carefully before signing.

We, the parents, have accepted the challenge to “train up a child in the way he should go” (Proverbs 22:6). in our home. We place our trust in Lakewood Park Christian School to extend that training more completely and to partner with us in this endeavor.

We understand that attendance at Lakewood Park Christian School is a privilege. The school may exclude our child if the administration believes he or she has failed to comply with the policies and discipline.

We understand the standards of Lakewood Park Christian School do not tolerate profanity, obscenity in word or action, dishonor to the Holy Trinity or the Word of God, or disrespect to the personnel of the school and ask that Lakewood hold our children to these standards.

We, the parents, agree to live a marital lifestyle consistent with the Biblical viewpoint described in Genesis 2:18-24 where marriage is between a naturally born male and a naturally born female.

We have read and agree to support the basis for the biblical worldview/curriculum, as stated in the Statement of Faith (See Form H), LPCS Mission Statement, “Teach-Proverbs 15:33; Train-Proverbs 22:6; Test-Proverbs 17:3; Transform-Proverbs 3:12.” and LPCS Vision Statement, “Shaping difference-makers in Christ.”

Spiritual Agreement

We affirm that we have read the Statement of Faith included in the LPCS Parent-Student Handbook, that we agree with this Statement of Faith, and that we are living a lifestyle that is in accordance with this Statement of Faith and training our child(ren) to do so too.

We understand that LPCS unashamedly believes, teaches, and practices a literal interpretation of the Word of God, the Bible. We agree with LPCS’s religious mission and beliefs, and are enrolling our child(ren) in this school because we desire a distinctively Christian education for our child(ren).

We acknowledge that Biblical principles are integrated into every subject taught at LPCS and the LPCS’s staff is committed not only to academic excellence, but also to teaching students how to apply God’s Word to every aspect of life. Because we are in agreement with the teachings of God’s Word as outlined in LPCS’s Statement of Faith, we believe enrollment of our child(ren) at LPCS will complement the beliefs and ideals we teach and practice at home.

We understand that Christian education is a partnership between parents and the Christian school and agree that we will not act in any way that would undermine this partnership.

In the event we experience difficulty in this partnership, we agree that we will handle this difficulty in accordance with the principles of Matthew 18:15-17 and related Scriptures, which lay outline following process.

- * The offended party should go to the alleged offender to privately discuss the offense and seek reconciliation.
- * If private discussions do not resolve the issue, the offended party should take one or two people with him as mediators to help seek reconciliation.
- * If mediation does not resolve the issue, the parties are to take the matter to the authority who can hear and judge the matter to make a final determination. (In most cases this would be the Superintendent.)
- * Believing that lawsuits between believers are prohibited by Scripture, we agree to submit to binding arbitration any matters which cannot otherwise be resolved, and expressly waive any and all rights in law and equity to bringing any civil disagreement before a court of law, except that judgement upon the award rendered by the arbitrator may be entered in any court having jurisdiction thereof.

We understand that expression of disagreement with or failure to adhere to LPCS’s Statement of Faith by us or our child(ren) can result in actions up to and including dismissal of our child(ren) from LPCS.
